# **Truly the Son of God**

Jesus constrained the disciples to take the ship and go to the other side of the lake, while He went onto a mountain to pray. While the disciples were toiling in a storm Jesus went to them walking on the water. The disciples were alarmed and thought it was a spirit, but when Jesus called unto them Peter desired to walk on the water to be with Jesus.
