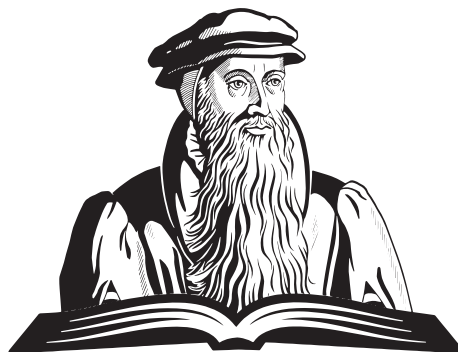

# Creation: The Work of an Almighty God

## Genesis 1

### Memory Verse

*In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.*

Genesis 1:1

### The Origin of Life

Many ungodly people believe that the world came into existence by accident. This accident is given the name evolution. However, as you read the first verse of Genesis you will find something truly amazing. The Bible reveals that the world did not come about by accident/chance. The first verse says, “In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.” How wonderful are these words! They are wonderful because they tell us that our life is not an accident, but came about by the will of God. Since God purposed to make man, man’s life has purpose. God created man out of His goodness so that man might worship and enjoy God and His creation.

### The Trinity in Creation

We also see the Triune God, when God created man. After creating all things, it was God’s desire to place man over the creation, so that He could rule over it. What do we read about the creation of man? We read that the persons in the Trinity desire to make man in His image – “And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness” (Genesis 1:26).

### God Almighty: An Encouraging Truth

The act of creation shows the almighty power of God. Many people create things. People make chairs, tables and beds, but they cannot create the trees that are needed to make them. People make trains, planes and automobiles, but they cannot create the ore that is needed to make them. People are capable of creating because they are made in the image of God, but they cannot create like God created. Every human creator needs material. However, God created everything out of nothing. He did not have to find the material. He created the material. Truly God is almighty.

Because of sin, fallen man no longer serves his original purpose – to have communion and fellowship with God, to glorify God and to enjoy Him. However, the fall of man did not affect the power of God. God is still almighty. The fact that God continues to be almighty should be an encouragement to sinners who desire to be reconciled to God. Because God is almighty, the God who created everything out of nothing, can and does create new hearts in fallen sinners – “Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them” (Hebrews 7:25). Why is He able to save to the uttermost? Because He is almighty.
