

3. Is anyone ever truly able to know whether they are of the elect or of the reprobate in this life?
<u>Practical Application</u>
1. Read the account of Nebuchadnezzar in Daniel chapter 4. Meditate on what this story teaches us about God's sovereignty.
2. Meditate on Psalm 23. How does the psalmist show the expression of faith, of trusting God who is perfectly in control of all things, and of resting in his promises?
