

Question 96: What is the Lord's Supper?

Answer: The Lord's supper is a sacrament, wherein, by giving and receiving bread and wine, according to Christ's appointment, his death is showed forth; and the worthy receivers are, not after a corporal and carnal manner, but by faith, made partakers of his body and blood, with all his benefits, to their spiritual nourishment, and growth in grace.

10. What are the blessings given by Christ to believers through the Lord's Supper?

Further Studies

1. May and should all that receive the Lord's Supper to receive both elements, the bread and the wine too?
2. Is the bread in this sacrament turned into the actual body of Christ (which is what the Roman Catholic Church teaches), because our Savior tells his disciples expressly, "This is my body"? How do you prove that?
3. How do believers receive spiritual nourishment and growth in grace in and by this sacrament?
